



MY WEB SERVICES TERMINATE SEPTEMBER 30TH, 2024

TO: District 11 A.A. Members -

Effective September 30th, 2024 my commitment to host and manage updates for the District 11 website will conclude. I would highly, highly, highly recommend you have your replacement solution in place no later than September 15th.

Understanding that having a printable meeting schedule and online meeting guide are paramount for the newcomer and the visitor to Alaska I would highly encourage the voting GSR's for their respective groups to decide via group conscience your next effective means of dispensing general A.A. related information with regular updates sooner versus later.

There is a popular trend in the Fellowship to tap into the A.A. approved meeting guide app for the local Central Office/Districts. Personally, I do not think that is a good idea because what happens people just check the app but do not potentially connect with other important information at the local level. ***The website I built does not have the ability to connect to the app*** but I will provide some guidance below:

⌘ Find your best company to host a new Wordpress website. Godaddy offers Wordpress web hosting for about \$25/month I believe.

⌘ Install Wordpress with the appropriate security and functional plugins like a contact form, etc. The new person/vendor might want to mirror the current infrastructure of pages that I have created and just copy and paste the text.

⌘ Next, install this app - <https://wordpress.org/plugins/12-step-meeting-list/> and follow the prescribed directions to input the meetings. Refer to this AA.Org FAQ for more information: <https://meetingguide.helpdocs.io/category/eeberj2xql-connecting-to-meeting-guide>

The absolute most important part of this process is that whomever takes over this website and connects to the AA meeting guide app ***must ensure all meeting listings are current as much as you can 24/7 365 days a year.***

I can minimally assist the new person company transition but I cannot be expected to teach or train a hobbyist all about web development, web hosting and how to setup an effective website. Please start working on this now and not in September.
